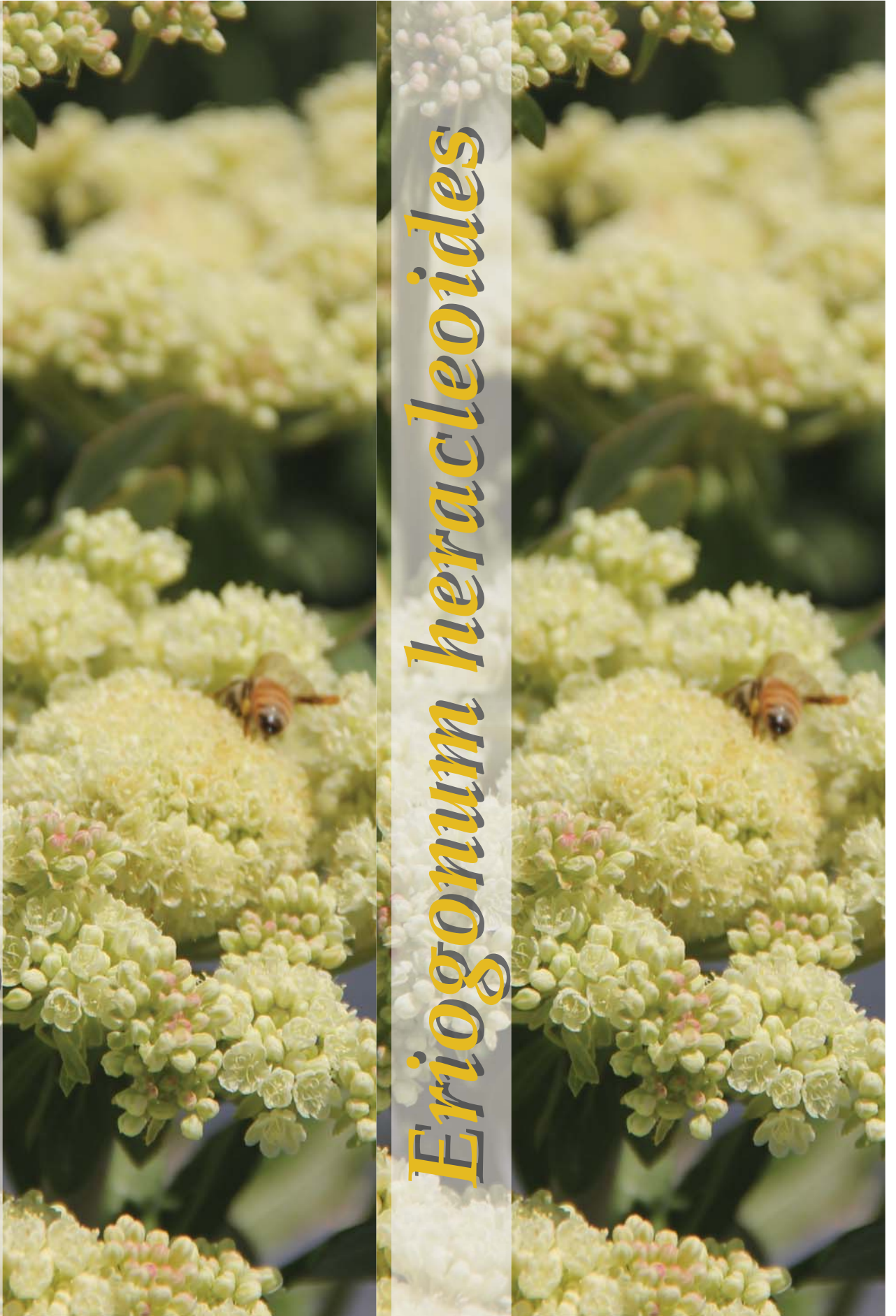

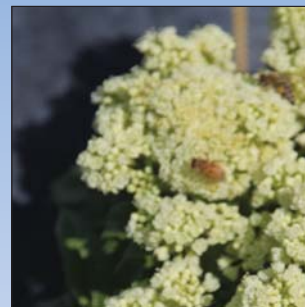

Suitable for 1 gallon pots and 2 gallon pots.
