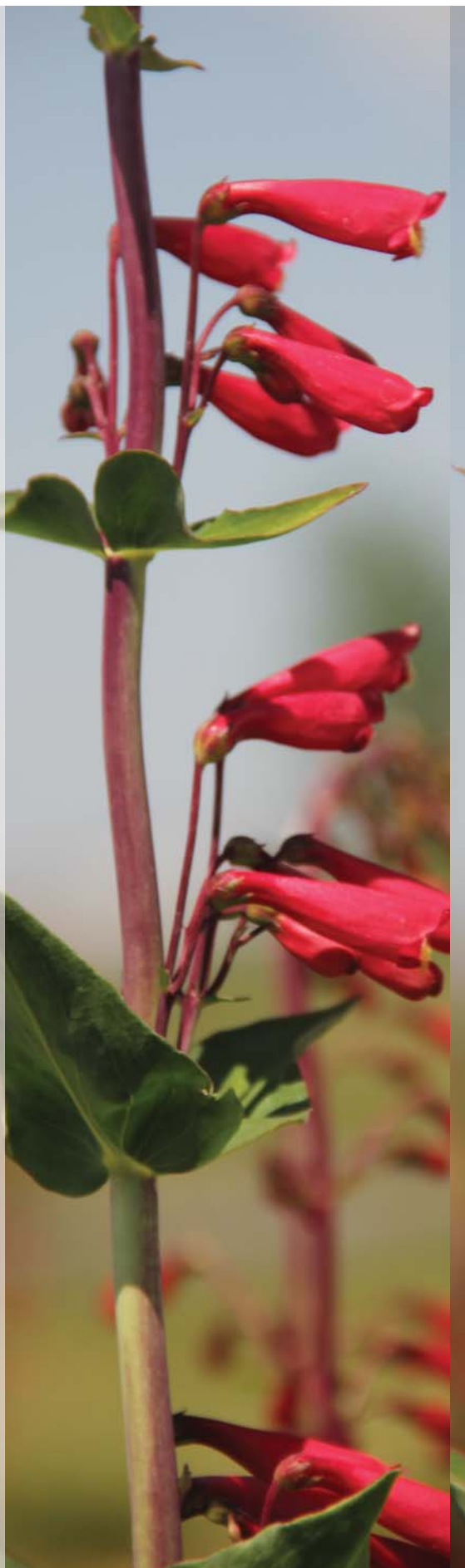
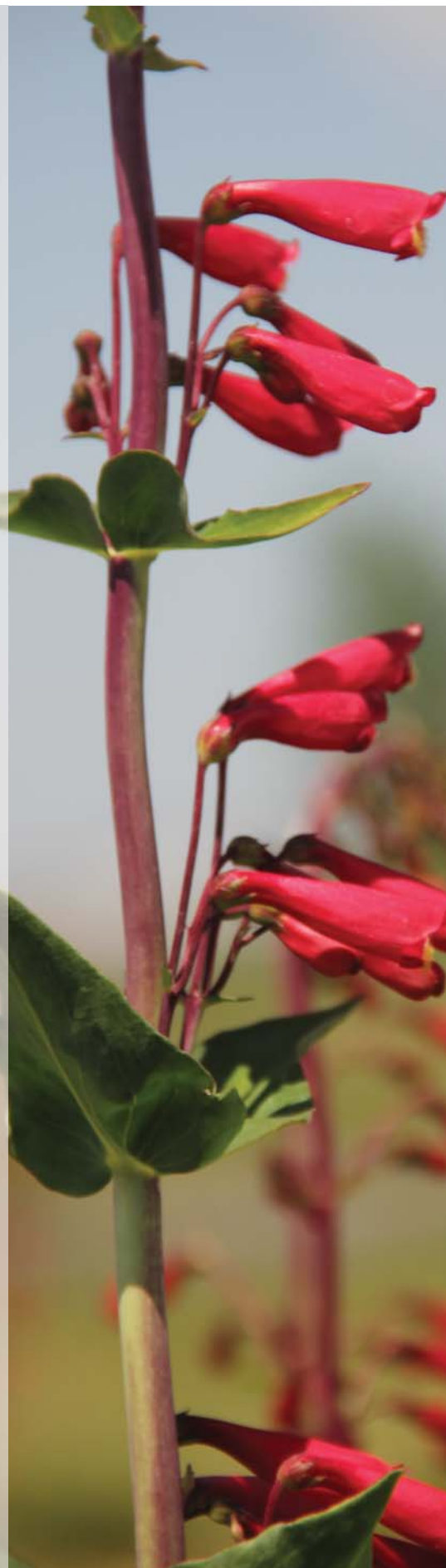

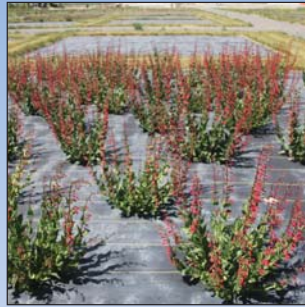
Cardinal Penstemon

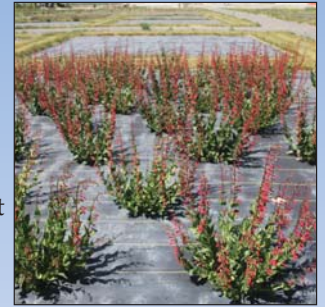
